Greetings from JIPMER

We are pleased to announce that the Hospital Infection Control and Prevention (HICP) unit of the Department of Microbiology JIPMER will be conducting the '**3rd National Workshop on Hospital Infection Control for Nurses**' between **18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January 2022 (for three days)** in JIPMER Pondicherry, India. The target participants will be **ONLY** infection control nurses working in the infection control units of the healthcare facility from different parts of India.

Infection Control is an essential component of any health care delivery system. Implementing infection control measures such as standard precautions like hand hygiene, personal protective equipment, environmental disinfection and equipment disinfection/sterilization etc. and transmission-based precautions can prevent the spread of microorganisms in health care settings. In times of COVID-19 pandemic, the requirement of infection prevention and control (IPC) practices has increased manifold. Unfortunately, an effective and robust infection control programme is lacking in most of the healthcare facilities in India.

Nurses play a crucial role in executing and implementing the infection control programme in health care services. Infection control nurses (ICNs) are the pillars of Hospital infection control and prevention (HICP) unit of the healthcare facilities. ICNs perform rounds, audits, surveillances and ensure the implementation of various infection control activities. Unfortunately there are paucity of training program for infection control nurses in India. This workshop aims at training the ICNs across the country on various aspects of hospital infection control which range from hand hygiene, personal protective equipment, HAI Surveillance, bundle care audit, needle stick injury, biomedical waste audit and environmental surveillance.

The number of participants selected for the workshop will be limited to 70. Nurses working in the infection control area only will be considered for this workshop. Applicants should discuss with their HODs infection control officer or equivalent before applying. If they are selected as participants, they need to submit a declaration form countersigned by their infection control officer or medical superintendent that they are working/ going to work in the infection control team of their institute and they will be responsible for implementing/augmenting IPC activities in their institute after completion of the workshop.

### Keeping the pandemic in mind, the following precautions will be undertaken.

- **COVID Status:** Participants will have to produce a negative COVID RT-PCR report and/or final vaccination certificate. Participants must be free of COVID symptoms at the time of journey and during workshop days.
- **Sight visit:** During/before workshop days, you are not allowed to roam around for sight visit. You can plan the same after the workshop is over.
- **CAB:** Participants will be strictly instructed to maintain COVID appropriate behavior (3-ply mask, hand rub and social distancing) all the time in the auditorium and will not be allowed to roam around the city in the evening hours
- **Refund criteria:** It is unlikely that the cases will rise in Pondicherry in recent future. However in unexpected circumstances, if lockdown is imposed because of increased case load, the workshop will be postponed and the full registration fees will be returned
- In case the participant will cancel because of COVID related reason, the registration fees will be returned. Otherwise, the registration fees once paid is non-refundable.
- **Mask:** Only 3-ply mask with back tie type to be worn during the workshop. Cloth mask, N95 respirator, or any other type masks are not allowed during the workshop. Two 3-ply masks will be required (pre-lunch and post lunch) per day. Mask need be worn all the times, including photography. Hanging mask or sliding mask is strictly prohibited.
- **Hand rub:** Participants need to carry pocket hand rub all the time and use as indicated.
